



## Evening tour of High Bentham

Bentham is a place of great historical interest. It was mentioned in the Domesday Survey, and the remains of a Saxon cross was discovered in the parish church of St John in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. It was granted a Market by the Crown in the 14<sup>th</sup> century and until 1974 was part of the old West Riding of Yorkshire. This promises to be a fascinating tour of a truly interesting historic settlement on our doorstep.
